|---|----------------------------|
| Tax returns, tax return supporting documents (if you do not file a return), record of mortgage payment | Indefinitely |
| Record of loan payment | Seven years |
| Tax return supporting documents (if you do not report income) | Six years |
| Tax return supporting documents | Three years |
| Quarterly investment records, quarterly retirement savings statements, credit card statements, pay stubs, medical bills, receipts for large purchases (or until the warranty expires) | One year |
| Credit cards bills (or until paid), receipts | One month |
| Utility bills | Until processed |
| Loan documents | Until paid |
| Home and auto insurance documents | Until you receive new ones |
| Home improvement records | While you hold the house |

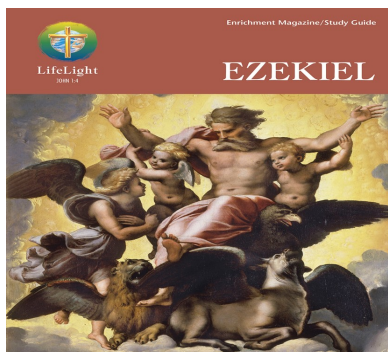

LifeLight Worship; Bible Study on Ezekiel

Please join us Wednesday, at 10:00 AM in the Fellowship Hall for our LifeLight Bible Study on the Old Testament Book of Ezekiel. Ezekiel was the prophetic voice of the LORD to the Jewish exiles in Babylon. His first task was to dispel any false notions that the temple and the city of Jerusalem would be preserved from the destruction the LORD had foretold. Then, after that has come to pass, Ezekiel was the LORD's voice of hope for the restoration of His people back in their homeland. Ezekiel speaks to the Church today in our exile in the broken sinful world as we await the final restoration in Eternal Life.

I invite you to join us in the Fellowship Hall Wednesday Evening, at 7:00 PM as we begin a new Bible Study Series based on the TV Series "The Chosen". Oooh, that scary time of year when little beggars ask for yummy treats is soon to be here.

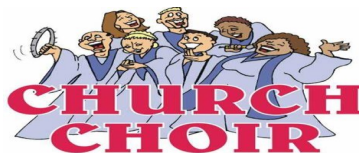
Lamb of God is having a WALK THRU Trick or Treat on Sunday, October 29*, 2023 from 3 until 5 p.m.
